The Town of Middlefield Selectboard has REFUSED to provide remote or hybrid access to any and all meetings at the Town Hall.

Although remote or hybrid access was requested twice last year the Selectboard REFUSED to provide it.

We in Middlefield need remote or hybrid access.

50% of our population is over 60 and many have health conditions and disabilities that prevent them from attending meetings in person.

Our ability to vote and share our opinions is severely restricted and the same relatively small group of residents control the outcome of every issue. We ALL deserve a voice.

The cost to provide remote/hybrid access according to the Massachusetts Office of Disability is \$2,000 or less.

A Bill has been introduced to force all towns to provide remote or hybrid access
